Learners will be encouraged to use their research to interpret the past and reflect on how South Australia has changed. Please adapt this guide to suit the needs of your learners.

#### Slide 4: Important Words

Clarify the learner's understanding of the keywords that will be used during the lesson.

#### Slide 5-7: Prior Knowledge & Context

Introduce Holden's history and significance to South Australia using prior knowledge, a short video (3 mins), and key facts and statistics.

#### Slide 8: Timelines

Show video to assist learners in understanding what a timeline is, and the key features of a useful timeline such as topic selection, time spacing, and labeling.



#### Slide 9: Task Instructions

Explain how to complete, the "Research Task - Timeline."

Students can complete their research individually, in pairs, or small groups. You may prefer to assign a specific car or year to engage interests or enable accessibility. You may like have learners complete the sheets together or separately

Note: The primary, middle, and secondary research worksheets include the same sequence of cars/years on the timeline, and can be substituted for learners requiring extension, modification, or adjustment.

#### Slide 10: Fast Finishers

Fast finishers can use the *Democracy Timeline* and *Defining Moments in Australian History* timeline to help fill in additional events in Australian and South Australian History.


