Clarify the learner's understanding of the keywords that will be used during the lesson.

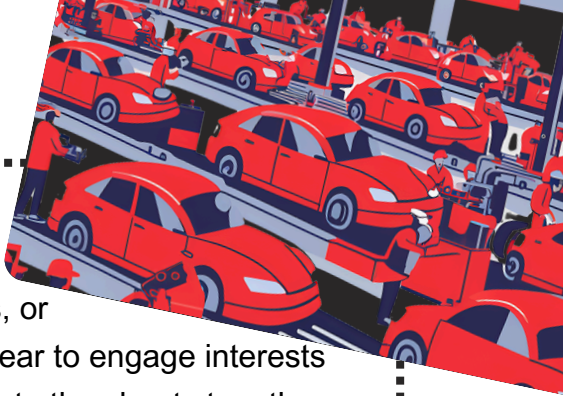
Slide 5-8: Prior Knowledge & Context

Introduce Holden's history and significance to South Australia using prior knowledge, a short video (3 mins), and key facts and statistics.

Slide 9: Timelines

Show video to assist learners in understanding what a timeline is, and the the key features of a useful timeline such as topic selection, time spacing, and labeling.





Slide 10: Task Instructions

Explain how to complete, the “Research Task - Timeline.”

Students can complete their research individually, in pairs, or small groups. You may prefer to assign a specific car or year to engage interests or enable accessibility. You may like have learners complete the sheets together or separately.

Note: The primary, middle, and secondary research worksheets include the same sequence of cars/years on the timeline, and can be substituted for learners requiring extension, modification, or adjustment.

Slide 11: Fast Finishers

Fast finishers can use the *Democracy Timeline* and *Defining Moments in Australian History* timeline to help fill in additional events in Australian and South Australian History.

This video assists learners in understanding how historians research. This includes selecting a topic, where to find useful sources, applying a research method, and including a balanced perspective.

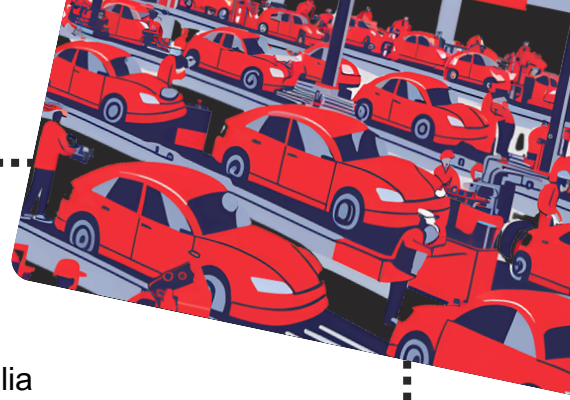
