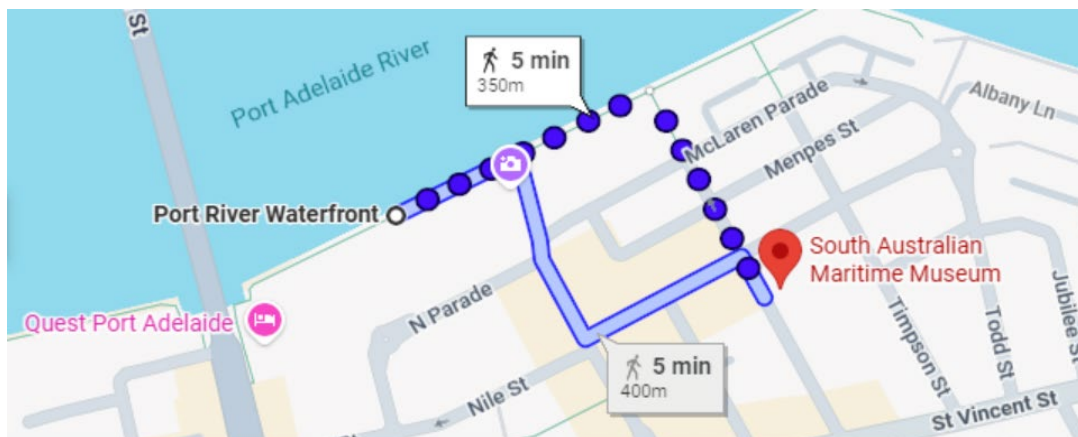


# South Australian Maritime Museum

## Booking a Port River Cruise on the *MV Archie Badenoch*

### Where is the Archie Badenoch located?

The vessel *MV Archie Badenoch* is moored at Queen's Wharf near the lighthouse. It is a short walk from the museum.



### How long is the cruise?

We allow one hour for this experience which includes walking time plus an allowance for students to each put on and take off a life jacket.

### How many students are permitted on board?

We can accommodate a **maximum of 20 students and up to 4 staff** only per trip.

### How can we ensure the students' safety?

All primary school students will be issued with a life jacket prior to boarding the vessel. School supervisors must help students to put their life jackets on. Secondary school students and adults will have access to life jackets on board if needed. We ask that all passengers wear enclosed shoes.

All passengers must follow the directions of the crew and remain inside the vessel.

**Duty of care remains the responsibility of school supervisors at all times.**

### Is the vessel accessible to everyone?

Unfortunately, the vessel is not wheelchair accessible, and infants and toddlers under 2 years of age are not permitted on board.

## Does the cruise operate in all weather conditions?

The cruise operates in most weather conditions, including rain, as the vessel provides some shelter. However, the tour may be cancelled if conditions are deemed unsafe or unsuitable – for example, in cases of high winds or when forecast temperatures reach 38°C or above. If a cancellation occurs, schools will have the option to reschedule their excursion to another date or choose an alternate program on the day.
